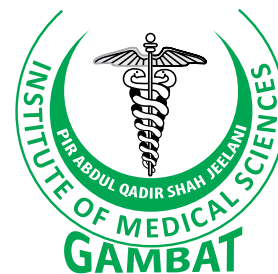

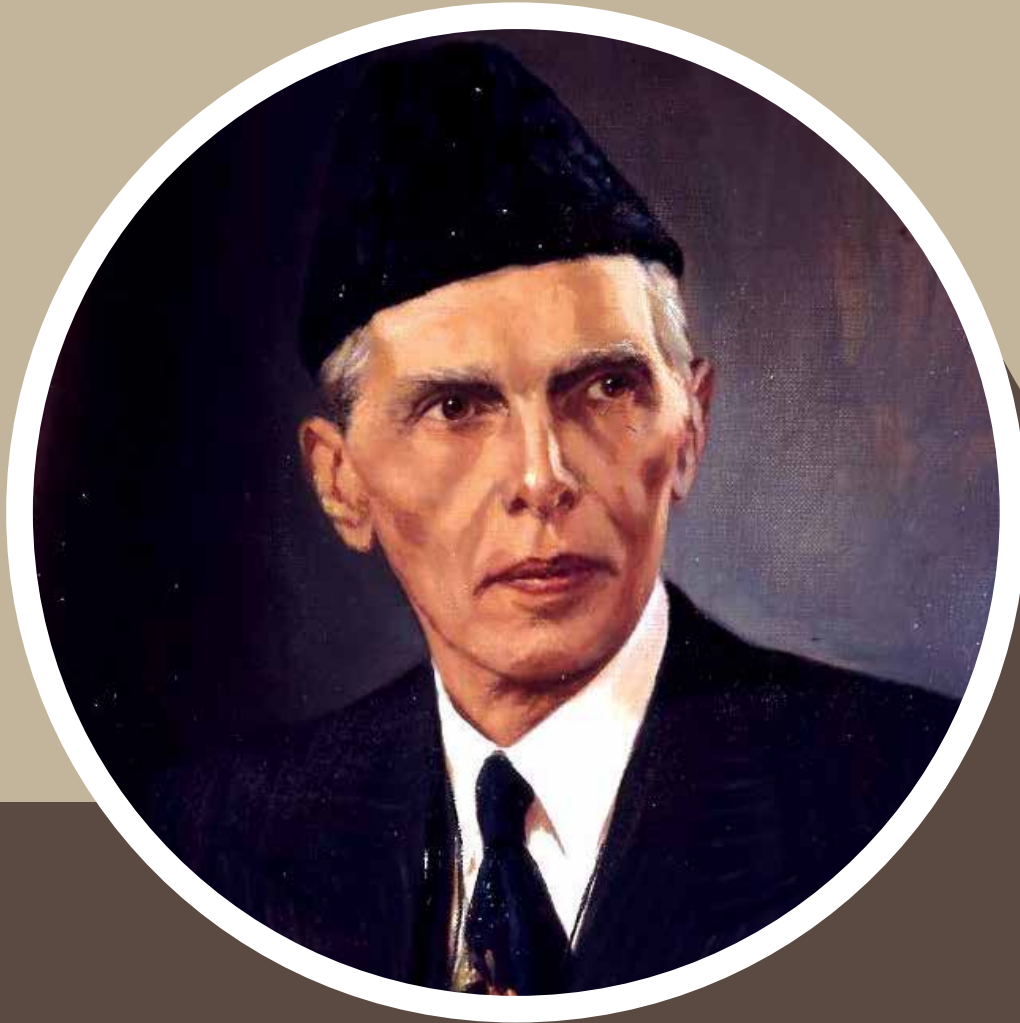

# HISTORICAL BACKGROUND OF THE INSTITUTE



2-room dispensary in 1934

This giant project was started from a 2-room dispensary, serving the people of Gambat since 1934. It was upgraded to the Taluka Hospital. In 1997, the THQ Hospital was declared a MODEL TALUKA HOSPITAL by MSU, World Bank, due to the efforts and devotion of Dr. Rahim Bux Bhatti, the Medical Superintendent.

Upgradation of Gambat THQ Hospital to GAMBAT INSTITUTE OF MEDICAL SCIENCES was announced by the Honorable Governor Sindh, which came under administrative control of Sindh Province on 10th September 2003. In 2005, a project was approved to strengthen GIMS and to start medical college.

The Institute was upgraded to degree-awarding institute, as a result of the untiring efforts of the Director and his team. The act was passed on 12th April 2011. Honorable Chief Minister Sindh Syed Qaim Ali Shah announced GIMS, as "INDEPENDENT DEGREE-AWARDING INSTITUTE". Later, Higher Education Commission of Pakistan recognized and issued "NO

OBJECTION CERTIFICATE" to this institute on 31st March 2015 vide Notification No. 15-18/HEC/A&A/2011/606 Dated: March 31, 2015, accrediting to run the medical college. This budding institute is progressing on its strong medical grounds. It will soon find its name among the high-ranking institutes of the country, based on its performance, especially, transparent admission process and vigilant examination department. The institute is in the process of expansion and very soon, new faculties will be added to it.

Sindh Assembly passed the Bill to award the name, as Pir Abdul Qadir Shah Jeelani Institute of Medical Sciences, Gambat.

The main objective of this institute is to provide state of art health facility at door step of needy people of Gambat and adjoining parts in general and to all the people of Sindh as to all the well of Pakistan. This institute extends its facility to all the provinces of Pakistan without any discrimination of caste and creed.

Gambat Medical College, will be admitting the 8<sup>th</sup> batch of MBBS Students and it will be having all seven batches of MBBS course. There are 100 seats allocated to 23 tagged districts of Sindh. The selection of the students is based on district wise quota with no discrimination of caste & creed. The aim is not only to produce competent doctors but also to inculcate high moral values in them through the education, which is focused to ensure that training and grooming of the students go hand in hand with modern requirements of medical institution. The college is recognized by the Pakistan Medical & Dental Council (PM&DC) Islamabad.

The college is a part of Pir Abdul Qadir Shah Jeelani Institute of Medical Science (PAQSJIMS), Gambat, the main campus is situated on the left bank of Rohri canal. The humid & cooler air coming from the canal, keeps atmosphere comfortable even in hot days. It is just half kilo meter away from the National Highway, the Highway which connects Sindh with other provinces of Pakistan.

Best possible medical education to the youngsters of the Sindh particularly the rural areas, is the main aim of establishment of this college and to provide health care facilities to the people not only of Sindh but also the adjoining areas of other provinces as well.

The college has dedicated and hard working teaching

faculty and so are the students the faculty is almost completed according to the PMC Islamabad criteria.

Everyone in the institute is committed to provide outstanding training & grooming of the students under the state of art facilities in purpose, a building with the basic teaching facility including air-conditioned modern Lecture halls, laboratories, demonstration rooms, library and central infra-structure which can be compared with any best medical institution in the country and abroad. All the lecture halls, demonstration rooms and seminar rooms are equipped with latest I.T facilities.

Postgraduate research center with various disciplines such as regenerative medicines, molecular medicines, P.G high-tech lab, and stem cell technology is going to be introducing after completion of our project.

PAQSJIMS, Gambat has played a pivotal role on flood disaster this year, we have taken steps by arranging flood relief camp, free medicine and our Consultant has served at affected areas.

The teaching hospital has state of the art clinical departments with the indoor as well as outdoor patients care clinical facility which is the requirement of a medical college when the students enter their clinical teaching. The bed strength of the hospital of the institute is 1000 beds to accommodate four batches of students.



## GAMBAT MEDICAL COLLEGE AT A GLANCE

### HISTORY:

Gambat Medical College (GMC) is in between old and new cities of Gambat Town, about 1 km away from Gambat Railway Station. Travelling on National Highway, new City of Gambat lies on the right side of the highway, if one moves to Karachi, having the moves to Karachi, having the Rohri Canal on the left side. After crossing Rohri canal, there is a complex of buildings, which is known as Pir Abdul Qadir Shah Jeelani Institute of Medical Sciences, (PAQSJIMS) Gambat. On the right side of the complex is a



giant building comprising of basic departments of Gambat Medical College (GMC). Four years ago, in the year 2017, it came into being as 100 students in 1st batch of MBBS course got admission. This was the result of untiring efforts of Dr. Rahim Bux Bhatti and his aim was to produce doctors with knowledge of medicine at par, with the help of doctors of well reputed institutes colleges, not only of Pakistan, but, also from abroad.

### RECOGNITION:

This Medical College is recognized by Pakistan Medical & Dental Council (PM&DC) for MBBS course. It is also recognized by Higher Education Commission (HEC), for various postgraduate degree and diploma courses.

### FACILITIES:

As far as its infrastructure is concerned, it has a marvelous infrastructure, comparable to any high class & high



ranked college not only in the Pakistan, but, abroad also. It is almost up-to mark, according to the requirements of PM&DC in the infrastructure and in the teaching faculty, as well. The College has four air-conditioned lecture halls. All the basic departments have their individual Laboratories, Tutorial rooms, Group discussion rooms and Museums. Anatomy department has a dissection hall. There is a large & capacious skill lab, with facility of tutorial room & a discussion room. All the above labs & rooms are air-conditioned.

The college is at par with any of good college/institution of Pakistan in academics. Basic Science faculty is up-to-mark according to PM&DC requirements, having professors, Associate Professors, Assistant Professors, Senior Registrars, Lecturers/ Demonstrators.



For practical work, the laboratories are well-equipped with latest gadgets, like Respirometers, Power Lab, Anatomy models & bones.

All the facilities are well-utilized and this is evident from the 1st university examinations, where two other senior colleges were competition, all the three positions were secured by this college, which is the result of hard work of the faculty & the students.

#### **LIBRARY:**



Library is backbone of any institute. This College has a state-of-the-art air conditioned library with separate portions for boys & girls. There are sufficient number of test books, as well as, reference books. There is large collection of books. Timings for students is from 8-0 am to 8-0 pm. Presently, there are few scientific journals which are likely to be increased in future, according to the needs.

#### **INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY:**

The Department is headed by an IT Engineer who has sufficient number of skilled people under him, who run the department. The Campus including basic departments, as well as, clinical departments have Internet facility and can be connected, through WiFi system.



#### **DIGITAL LIBRARY:**

Digital Library is need of any institute nowadays. This College has been provided facility by HEC Islamabad to get benefit of more than 25,000 latest online journals and books, free of cost. This facility can be utilized by the teachers, as well as, the students, equally. It has more than 100 computers with ocean to hundreds of online journals.

#### **COMPUTER LABORATORY:**

Computer laboratory equipped with latest computers, laptops, multimedia, scanners, and printers is available for the students and faculty of the college. IT head supervises this department.

#### **CONFERENCE ROOMS:**



There are two audio and one video conference room. Through video conference, online workshops, seminars & special Lectures can be arranged.

#### **ACADEMIC ACTIVITIES:**



There are academic activities, such as workshops, Conferences & awareness programs being organized by the college, like World Hepatitis Day, World Mother's Day, and Awareness

of Breast-feeding etc. A mega event of National Preventive Cardiology Conference was arranged a couple of years ago in which delegates from all the country and abroad participated.

#### EXTRA CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES:



Apart from academic activities, some informative and spiritual programs are organized by the college-viz Seerat Conference, Sports Week. The students participate in quiz competition, held in other colleges, as well.

#### TEACHING HOSPITAL:

The teaching hospital has sufficient number of beds for clinical teaching of all the three batches of MBBS students. About 1000 bedded hospital, having the facility of all the specialties is available for teaching purpose of students.

Apart from the tertiary care, there are facilities for special care, as well, e.g. angiography, angioplasty & bypass surgery Kidney transplant, liver transplant Cornea transplant, Oncology department has started working, where cancer treatment is being given. Bone marrow transplantation has also been started.

## ADMISSION REGULATIONS

The admission regulations of Pakistan Medical Commission (amended) 2024-2025 will be followed regarding the admissions in MBBS Course at GAMBAT Medical College of Pir Abdul Qadir Shah Jeelani Institute of Medical Sciences, Gambat. The college will follow the rules and regulations issued from time to time by PMDC.

### Preparation of Merit List

The admitting university for admission to medical universities and colleges this year is Liaquat university of medical and health sciences(LUMHS), Jamshoro nominated by Sindh Government, has to make the merit List of all the candidates of the Sindh province according to the districts.

### Filling of Merit Seats

- a) General Merit Seats: The general merit seats will be filled according to the district wise merit of respective districts.
- b) IEAP/ Self Finance (Local): Applications to fill IEAP local seats will be invited separately. All the appropriate applications complete n all respects consisting all the attested photostat copies of

required documents including a copy of DD/ Banker's Cheque of required amount in the name of "Director PAQSJIMS, Gambat" will be included for competition. Complete merit list will be formed. First top 15 candidates will be offered to get admission.

### Filling of Vacant Seats

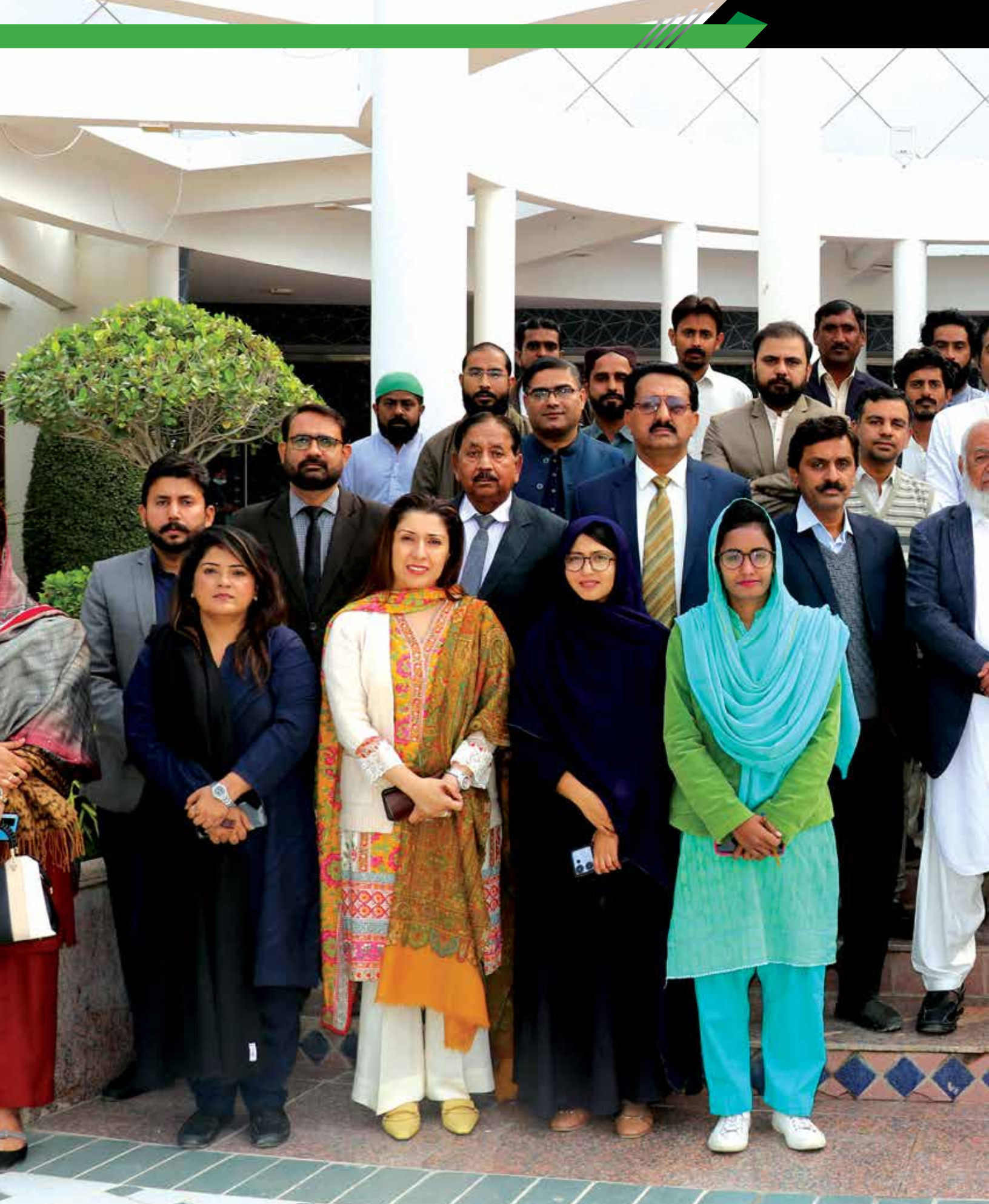
- a. General Merit Seats: If seat/seats remain vacant, that will be filled by offering the next waiting candidate in respective districts. The process will be repeated until all the allocated seats in all districts are filled completely, up to the last date of closing the admissions.
- b. IEAP /Self Finance (Local): If seat/seats remain vacant, the next waiting candidate from the self-finance list will be called for admission. The process will be repeated until all the allocated seats are filled completely, up to the last date of closing the admissions.

**Note:** No seat/seats will be filled after last date of filling the seats in any category, if remain vacant.

# FEES PAYMENT RULES

## RULES FOR PAYMENT OF FEE

Rules of Payment of Fees are same as mentioned in the Prospectus of Government of Sindh for admission to MBBS/BDS, Session 2025-26, for Medical Universities and Colleges of Sindh Province.

Candidates selected for admission in 1st year MBBS under any category will have to deposit fees within three working days. The students will have to Pay the prescribed fee for remaining years at the start of each session within stipulated time period i.e. 15 days

Note: (i) The challan form of required fee will be issued by directorate of Finance.

(ii) The DDs/Banker's cheques of IEAP students will be submitted to Directorate of Finance along with the list of students. The information of deposition of DDs/Banker's cheque be communicated to Directorate of Admission for record.

2. The Director of Admissions will provide the complete data or admitted students to the concerned departments.

3 Fee is subject to revision by the College/Health Department Government of Sindh at any time during the course of study and will be applicable at

once for all years.

4. If any student in subsequent years fails to deposit fee/dues within stipulated time period, he/she shall not be eligible to appear in examination. If student appeared in examination without clearing dues, the Controller of Examinations will be held responsible

5. In case a student appeared in Examination with the permission of the competent authority, the Controller of Examination will Withhold the examination result till issuing of No Dues Certificate from Finance Department.

6. The Finance Department will be responsible to collect the prescribed fee from students. If any student fails to deposit the prescribed fee, the Directorate of Finance will issue notice to the defaulter student

7. Late payment will be charged as per college policy.

8. Convocation and degree fee will be charged from students at the time of submission of tuition fee of final year.

9. Students who fail to submit college fees within the due date will be ineligible to receive any benefits from the college, including extracurricular activities.



## PAYMENT OF FEE

1. Fee for the 1st Year should be paid, within 2 weeks of admission.
2. Fee for remaining years will have to be paid, upto 4 weeks of the start of each academic year.
3. In case the fee is not deposited, upto the given specified time, late payment charges will be charged, as per rules: After four months of non-payment, the seat is liable to be cancelled and student will not be allowed to appear in any examination.
4. Government Tax of 5% is levied on tuition fee of above Rs. 2 Lacs and this has to be paid by the student.
5. Fee may be revised by the University, at any time, during course of the study, due to unavoidable circumstances.
6. The candidate, who fails to clear his/her dues, within stipulated time shall not be allowed to appear in any examination.

## ACADEMICS & RULES OF EXAMS AT SMBBMU, LARKANA

### GENERAL CLAUSES

1. Shaheed Mohtarma Benazir Bhutto Medical University, Larkana shall hold all examinations, with one supplementary examination of each professional examination.  
Examination shall start with a minimum gap of two weeks, after completion of course.
2. Examination Calendar shall be prepared by the Controller examinations, in consultation with the concerned Dean of Faculty and with the approval of Vice Chancellor.
3. Controller of Examination shall prepare and notify the date for the theory and practical examination. Date sheet once notified, shall not be changed, however; the Vice Chancellor, under exceptional Circumstances (to be recorded in writing), may recommend a change in the date sheet.
4. The Chairman concerned must certify that the candidate has actually attended 75% of the lecturers, delivered and practical clinical sessions, conducted during the Academic Year in each of the subject.
5. The candidate shall be required to submit their Examination Forms on or before the date notified for the purpose alongwith prescribed regular fee and with the double of normal fee, till 7 Days, before the commencement of the examination. The Examination department shall not entertain the incomplete examination forms.

6. The examination fee once deposited shall not be refunded. Admit card, shall bear the stamp of the Controller of Examinations.

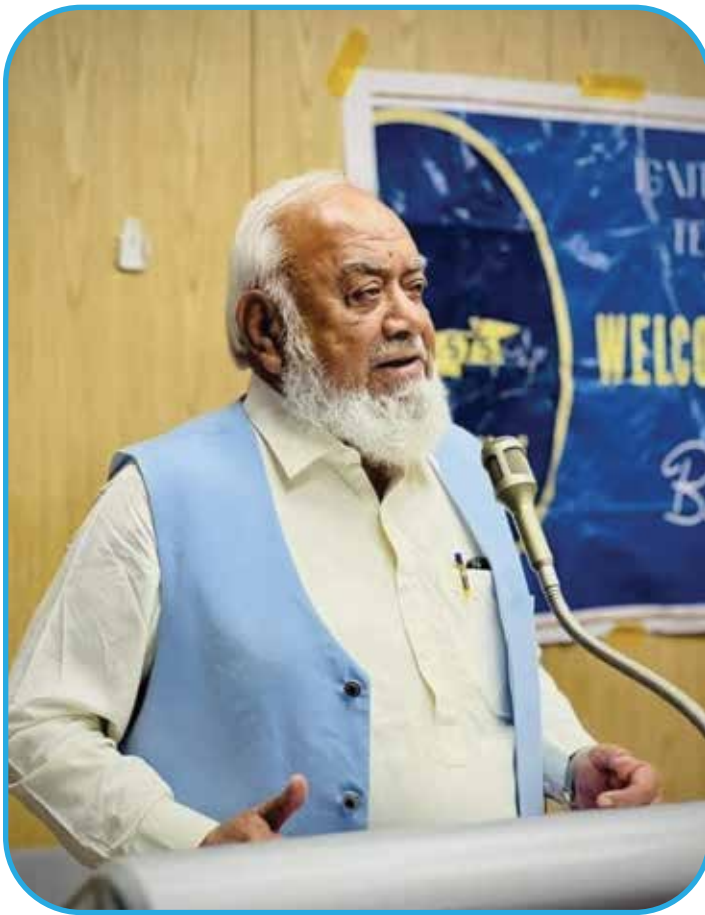
### FORMAT OF THEORY EXAMS

1. Annual shall be system of Examinations for all professional under -graduate MBBS Examinations.
2. Theory and practical shall have 50% each of total marks and theory shall be BCQs and SEQs type
3. The theory papers shall be made from Q. bank and questions, invited from different examiners.
4. BCQs portion shall be of 70% marks, including 2 BCQs of tag subjects in first and second year only per 35 BCQs. 30% of marks shall be allocated to SEQs. (6 questions including 1 question of tag subject).

### OSPE/OSCE EXAMINATIONS

1. In basic subjects (Anatomy, Physiology, Biochemistry, Pharmacology, Forensic Medicine, Pathology and Community Medicine) following shall be distribution of marks in Practical /Viva Voce.

- Viva voce/ Interactive OSPE 45%
- Practical 15%
- OSPE (Static) on multimedia 30%  
(10 stations each station carry 3 marks)
- Internal evaluation 10%  
(5% attendance, 5% departmental tests).



2. In clinical subjects (E.N.T, Eye, Medicine, Surgery, Gynae/ Obs, Peadiatrics) the distribution of marks shall be as below:

- Log Book 15%
- Long Case 25%
- Short Case 20%
- (2 Short Case 10% + 10%)
- OSCE 30%  
10 stations; each station carry 3 marks
- Internal Evaluation 10%
- (5% attendance, 5% departmental/ward tests).
- OSPE / OSCE (Static) will be conducted on Multimedia, at the time, in all constituent/ affiliated Medical Colleges, along with the theory paper.
- Each examiner has to submit their individual results in sealed envelope to the Convener of Examinations, separately and he/she will submit the same to Controller Examinations Department on same day.
- Internal evaluation marks shall be awarded by the conveners of the Examinations and

sent to Controller Examinations 1 week before commencing theory examinations.

- Final result of practical will be compiled and awarded by the conveners.
- There shall be meeting of the invigilation and supporting staff with Controller Examinations, 1 day before examinations, for proper and smooth conduction of the examination.

### DISCIPLINES IN EXAMINATIONS

Following rules shall govern the discipline in examinations

#### a. Constitution of Examination Discipline Committee

There shall be an Examinations Discipline Committee, which shall consist of:

- i. One Dean to be appointed as Chairman by the Syndicate.
- ii. One Senior Professor of the University, to be appointed by the Vice Chancellor.
- ii. One Principal of an affiliated college, to be appointed by the Vice Chancellor.
- iv. The Controller of Examinations.

#### b. Functions

The functions of the Examinations Discipline Committee shall be:

- i. To deal with and scrutinize the cases of the alleged uses of unfair means by the candidates,



- ii. appearing at any university examination.
- ii. To deal with all other matters, effecting the discipline of the candidates, at university examinations.
- iii. To award punishment, the candidates to adopt malpractice and create in discipline in the examinations.

2. The committee may call a candidate alleged of using unfair means in the examination, hearing him/ her, in person, before any decision is taken.
3. A candidate aggrieved by the decision of the Examination Discipline Committee may appeal to the Vice Chancellor against the decision of the Committee, within 30 days from the date of receipt of the decision of the committee. The decision of the Vice Chancellor shall be final, and shall not be called in question in any court of law.

### **JURISDICTION BAR**

As per ruling of honorable, Supreme Court of Pakistan, Ref. 2016 SCMR 134, Criteria laid down in University prospectus, interpretation of -- non-interference by courts- in matters of admission and examination in educational institution, the university authorities concerned were the sole judges of the criteria, laid down in the prospectus - Quotes in such matters desist from interfering, as it would create difficulties for the institutions to run their affairs in an appropriate manner, according to their rules and regulations.

4. The members of the Examination Discipline Committee, other than ex-officio members, shall hold office for 2 years.
5. The quorum for a meeting of the Examinations Discipline Committee shall be 3 members.



### **NOTICE AND EX-PARTE DECISION**

Notice of hearing shall be given to the candidate to the postal address of the candidate; and if by the given date and time the candidate fails to appear before the Committee, the Controller Examinations shall Send second notice to the accused candidate, by giving him / her fresh date and time to present himself/ herself, before the Discipline, else ex-parte decision will be taken against him/her. The notice will be sent by registered post or courier service to the address, given by the candidate.

### **DECISION OF THE EXAMINATION DISCIPLINE COMMITTEE**

The Examination Discipline Committee after taken into consideration the evidence on record, and the explanation and evidence, given by the candidate, will give their decision, in writing and a copy of a decision will be supplied to the candidate.

### **APPEAL**

If a candidate has valid reason to appeal against the decision of the Examination Discipline Committee, he/she may do so, within one month from the date of receipt of the decision, addressed to the Vice Chancellor, who may refer the appeal to the Syndicate.



## REPRESENTATION BY ANY LEGAL ADVISOR

No Lawyer or any Legal Advisor shall be allowed to appear on behalf of assist an accused candidate, during inquiry or appeal, under these Regulations. Only the candidate shall be heard, in person.

## POWERS OF VICE CHANCELLOR TO AWARD PUNISHMENT, IN CASES OF DISTURBANCES IN EXAMINATION

Notwithstanding anything contrary to these Regulations, the Vice Chancellor shall have the



powers to summarily award suitable punishment, without referring to the Examination Discipline Committee, to any candidate or to any student on the rolls of constituent institution or to any person who creates disturbances of any kind during examination or otherwise misbehaves in or around any examination hall or becomes arrogant or insolent with the invigilation Staff or inspectors or the University Authorities.

## BEHAVIOR OF THE CANDIDATE IN THE EXAMINATION HALL AND AROUND THE EXAMINATION CENTRE

candidate who refuses to obey the Head Invigilator or changes his/ her seat, with another candidate or creates disturbance of any kind, during a particular paper of an examination or otherwise misbehaves in or around the Examination Hall, maybe expelled by the Head Invigilator and maybe disallowed from appearing in the particular paper of the examination. He/ She may however, be allowed to take the remaining papers of the examinations, if the Head Invigilator is satisfied that he / she would behave appropriately in the remaining papers.

In addition, if he/she threatens to commit or commits breach of peace and law he/she may be prosecuted



under relevant law in force and maybe handed over to the police.

The Head Invigilator may inform to the Controller of Examinations, without delay, every such case in detail and Controller Examination shall take steps to inform the Vice Chancellor of these cases, for necessary action.



## POSSESSION OF UNAUTHORIZED MATERIAL

If a candidate is found having in his/her possession papers, books or any other material, specially mobile phone and any electronic device which might

possibly be of assistance to him shall be deemed to have used unfair means.

**UNFAIR MEANS AND COPYING ETC.**

Subjects to the generality of the word as defined, unfair means shall also include the following:

- I. Removing the leaf from his / her answer book.
- II. Abusive or offensive language in his / her answer book
- III. Making an appeal to the examiner in his / her answer book etc.
- IV. Refusing to obey instructions, issued to him/ her, by the University.
- V. Creating disturbance during the examination.
- VI. Taking the whole or part any answer book or supplement into or out of an examination Centre.

**NOTE:**

Any change in rules by the affiliated University will be followed as per directions.



# LIBRARY



1. Only one book will be issued from the library, at a time
2. No book shall be kept by any student, for more than 14 days. This privilege does not include the vacations. For each succeeding day that a book been kept, there shall be a fine of five rupees; but the total fine shall not exceed the price of the book. Further issue books shall be stopped, till the fine is paid and the books is returned to the library.



3. . If the reason of non-return of book in time is beyond the control or the student and the Director / Principal is satisfied, he may reduce the fine.
4. . Text books prescribed by the Institute shall not be issued to the students.
5. Every borrower will be supplied with a borrower's student card, which shall be stamped by the librarian, every time a book is issued/returned. If a card is lost, a new card is to be purchased from the Librarian, for five rupees.
6. The book card placed in the pocket at the end of the book must be delivered to the librarian, before the book is taken away and the borrower must have it stamped.
7. The borrower card is not transferable.
8. During stock taking, which will be notified, all books taken must be returned.
9. Periodicals and newspapers received for the students section are placed on the table for the use of the students and must not be taken away, under any circumstances.

## RULES FOR OTHERS

1. A time limit of 14 days for keeping books is allowed for all members other than professors and lecturers, who are engaged in teaching Non-observance of this is liable to deprive them of the privilege of use of the library. Not more than two books will be issued for taking out, at a time. Fresh books will be issued, only after the return of previously issued books.
2. Books required by the professor, if taken out by any other me must be returned on receipt of a notice from the librarian
3. Borrowers other than professors and lecturers, may renew books, issued to them by a formal request to the librarian. The books renewed will be liable to be recalled, if required.
4. The Librarian shall inform the professors and the lecturers of the receipt of all new books, which shall be kept in a separate almirah for a fortnight, before being issued.
5. Current number of journals shall be kept in the staff reading room and left there till the next issue is received; when the last issue becomes available for issuing. For issuing a journal, preference will be given primarily to the department, to which journal is of interest
6. Professors are allowed to keep a departmental library, of reference books pertaining to their subjects. But, these departmental libraries are open to the members of the staff, and a book wanted by a reader shall be supplied to him, by the librarian from the departmental libraries. Such reader will be directed to the departmental library of which the professor is solely responsible.
7. Professors can be issued up to 12 books, at a time, and the period of issuance will be one month; on the expiry of which the books should be returned or got reissued.
8. Associate Professors and Assistant Professors can get five and three books, at a time, respectively, and can keep them for a fortnight.
9. Demonstrators and registrars can be issued 2 books, at a time, to a period of 15 days.

### **ADMINISTRATIVE STRUCTURE OF HOSTELS**

Student hostel is headed by a warden. Students Management committee will look after hostel messes, in consultation with Hostal Incharge/assistant warden.

### **ADMISSION TO THE HOSTEL**

- The Institution is not bound to provide hostel accommodation to every student. However, accommodation will be provided subject to availability and on merit.
- There are separate hostels for boys and girls. These hostels are open, only to students; on the respective college roll.
- Hostel accommodation will be given to students, seeking admission in the medical institute, domiciled in places, other than the city in which the institution is situated. Day-scholars cannot apply, except under special circumstances.
- The Head of the institution, on recommendations of the Hostal Incharge, may refuse admission or reject the application of a student, if he/ she is of the view that he/she is not a desirable person to live in the hostel.
- Seats shall be allotted by the Hostal Incharge, in order of seniority and merit which will be determined by the year of study and by the marks obtained at the last university/ promotion examination.
- Failure in a class will be a discredit.
- In making allotment, the warden will also take into consideration, the status of a boarder, as well as, his/her conduct and character. Hostel allotment of students with outstanding dues is liable to Cancellation.
- Final year-remanded students maybe provided hostel accommodation, subject to availability.
- Na hoarder is allowed to change his/her seat or accommodation, provided by hostel without special permission of a Hostal Incharge concerned.
- If a student who is allotted hostel accommodation is not personally residing and the Administration finds the misuse of the room i.e. keeping unlawful or illegal occupants, his/her allotment will be cancelled and the case will be referred to the Disciplinary Committee, for further necessary action.

- The students will abide by the rules, promulgated by the Director and Principal, from time-to-time.
- Students are not allowed to keep fire arms or narcotics in their room in hostels.
- Unauthorized guests will not be allowed to live in the hostels. If such case is reported, strict disciplinary action will be taken against the students, who accommodated the unauthorized guests.
- No female guest/student is allowed in the boys hostels and no male guest/student is allowed in the girls hostel, under any circumstances
- Each Boarder will pay all hostel and mess dues, by the specified date. Defaulters will not be allowed to live in the hostel.
- Any student, guilty of misconduct and violation of hostel rules will be expelled from the hostel by the Principal, at the advice of the warden of hostels.
- The students will be responsible for paying extra dues for additional use of electric appliances, like air conditioner, refrigerators, microwave ovens etc, if allowed on seeking prior permission.

### **TIMINGS OF THE HOSTELS**

#### **Boys Hostel**

All students should be present in their rooms by 10:00 p.m. Assistant Warden (or his representative) will check the presence of students in their rooms, at 10:15 p.m. The name of the absentees will be reported to the Hostal Incharge.

#### **Girls Hostel**

All girl-students should be present in the hostel rooms/premises, by 8:00 PM. They shall provide a list of visitors, duly approved by their parents guardian to the Assistant Warden. A record register of departure & arrival by the Assistant Warden will be maintained to record the timings of girl students, going out of the hostel in the afternoon

### **VISIT OF THE CITY FOR BOARDER STUDENTS**

For visit of the city, specific days are fixed for the boys and girls and college transport will be available for the purpose

### **DUTIES OF THE HOSTEL INCHARGE**

- Warden carries out the implementation of hostel

policy, as prescribed.

- He/She is responsible for overall discipline in the hostels.
- He/she takes all steps to make hostels, as comfortable for students, as possible.
- He/She arranges indoor games in the hostel and encourages healthy interaction among the students.
- He/She ensures best quality arrangements for students mess.
- He/She keeps close scrutiny on hostel accounts, relating to mess and general store items.

## DUTIES OF ASSISTANT WARDENS

- They carry out the policies of Principal and Warden, regarding hostels.
- They assist the warden in maintenance of discipline, in the hostel and ensure that all students are in their rooms, by a specific time, at night.
- They report all infringements of discipline, immediately to the warden.
- They ensure excellent sanitary conditions in the hostels and the messes.
- They prepare duty rosters of hostel servants.



## HOSTEL AND MESS RULES

### A. ALLOTMENT OF HOSTEL

For the purpose of Hostel, allotment of accommodation, maintains discipline and conduct, arranging and organizing messes, the following rules and regulations, as laid down hereinafter shall be followed.

#### 1. CONDITIONS OF ALLOTMENT FOR ACCOMMODATION IN THE HOSTEL.

- i. Hostel accommodation to the students is subject to the availability of vacant seats.
- ii. The preference of allotment of Hostel Accommodation shall be, as follows:
  - a) District other than the district Khairpur, where the college is located.
  - b) The city Gambat where the college is located.
- iii. Allotment in the hostel shall not be claimed, as a matter of right, even when a person is a bona fide student of the institution.
- iv. Allotment for the accommodation in the hostel will be considered, only after the Allotment Committee has scrutinized and satisfied itself with the merit and eligibility.
- v. Allotment of accommodation in the hostel will be for the Academic Year, only.
- vi. Maximum period in hostel under no circumstances be more than duration of maximum accommodation academic year.
- vii. Use of gas shall be not allowed in the Hostel.
- viii. Any noise making disturbances like any type of functions/celebrations days shall not be allowed in the Hostel.

#### 2. CONDITIONS OF INELIGIBILITY

The following shall be ineligible for allotment of accommodation:

- i. A student rusticated, expelled, or barred from the college.
- ii. A student wanted by the police or any other law enforcing agency in any criminal case.
- iii. A student, convicted by court of law.
- vi. A student who has been found and held guilty of misconduct.
- v. A student whose presence in the hostel is deemed to be determinate or pre-judicial to the peace,

tranquility and academic atmosphere.  
vi. Resident, once expelled from the hostel.

#### 3. Allotment procedure

- i. Application for allotment of accommodation in the hostel to be made by the bona fide student of the college on prescribed
- ii. In case of foreign student, the recommendation and undertaking on the prescribed proforma for the admission as the guarantee for the payment of hostel dues and good behavior from respective embassy or consulate.
- iii. The application shall be considered for allotment by the Committee, according to the laid down criteria.
- iv. Allotment to be reviewed on yearly basis.
- v. The allotment of accommodation will be made, after the candidate has produced payment receipt of the fees.
- vi. Residents shall sign a receipt of Hostel's property public assets in the room and shall be responsible for any loss and damage.
- vii. Resident shall abide by all the rules and discipline conduct and regulations that maybe enforced in the hostel, from time to time.

#### 4. CONDUCT AND DISCIPLINE

The following are the rules in addition to the rules of conduct, which may be prescribed from time to time:-

Acts of indiscipline or misconduct

- a. Keeping fire arms and other lethal weapons.
- b. Keeping un-authorized person in the room.
- c. Shifting to a seat/ room to another room other than the one allotted.
- d. Sub-letting the seat/ room allotted to the resident.
- e. Not handing over the position to the authorities, at the end of the period of allotment.
- f. Non-payment of hostel dues.
- g. Keeping or making use of illicit drugs or other intoxicants.
- h. Keeping electric appliances, such as refrigerator, air condition, television, oven, burner, heater etc. in the room.
- i. Engaging in any immoral, agitating and violent activities.
- j. Inviting or entertaining female visitor in the male hostel or vice versa.
- k. Staging sit-ins, lockups, occupying hostel warden's office or any other administrative office
- l. Use of abuse language.
- m. Inviting outsiders to address hostel resident, without the permission of authorities.
- n. Pasting of posters/chalking on hostel building.
- o. Staying away from the hostel premises, after 11 pm, in case of male students and after 9 pm, in case of female without prior permission.

## 5. ACTION AGAINST INDISCIPLINE

- i. Depending upon the similarity of the indiscipline or act of violation, on the part of the resident, of the hostel, the defaulter student shall be dealt with, according to the institutional rules.
- ii. Following the allegation of act of violence, the Principal may provisionally cancel the allotment and refer the matter to the college Disciplinary Committee, for probing into the matter and recommendation for necessary punishment.
- iii. In case of loss, due to vandalism, the matter relating to assessment of damage /loss will be referred to the disciplinary committee, the shall assist the loss and also fix the responsibility and extend of loss of the person, liable for the act, from whom recovery should be effected.



## MESS MANAGEMENT SYSTEM

- Two separate mess committees have been constituted supervise the messes of hostels for Boys and Girls respectively.
- The Assistant Warden ensures appropriate excellent standard or cleanliness & quality of food in the messes.
- Proper record of meals, taken by the student and payments made by them is maintained by a hostel clerk.
- Assistant Warden verifies the claims of cooks, regarding the mess bills and will check attendance record of cooks & hostel servants.
- Students will pay a specified amount of money for payment of salary of hostel and mess employees.
- The Principal exercises his discretionary power to resolve by rectifying the rules for any problem, being faced by the students, regarding the messes of the hostels.
- Mess will be managed by the students under the supervision of the supervision of the Assistant Warden. All boarders shall eat from the respective messes.
- Members may elect their own mess manager. Mess menu and its cost will depend upon the taste, likes and dislikes of the students themselves.
- Students must settle their accounts with the shops, every month, regularly. Accounts with the shops, whenever due will be recovered from the students' security deposit.
- Meals must be served in the Dining Room and must not be taken in the living rooms.
- Any member intends to be absent from a meal must notify the manager/cook at least 12 hours before, otherwise they will be charged for it.
- Each student will deposit in the Hostel office a sum of Rs.1000/- for Pakistani students and Rs.1500/- for foreign students, as Mess Advance (Security). Any student, who does not pay the mess advance, will not be entertained.
- The warden of the hostels can fix the mess security according to the prevalent market prices of eatables.
- Mess advance will be returned after adjusting the student accounts, only when they finally leave the hostel.
- Members will pay expenditure of previous months, before the 7th of every month after which the Assistant Warden, with the permission of the warden may debar any student from the use of mess, till the latter has paid the expenses (plus a penalty of Rs.10/), per day.
- On return from vacations, members shall clear their accounts of the last working month, within five days or their return to the hostel. Defaulters shall be liable to penalty. The hostel clerks under the supervision of the warden will maintain the accounts The cook will draw money from the clerk, twice a week. This will be done on a written request by the Mess Manager on the printed form. The Mess Manager will be responsible for maintenance of proper mess account, who will submit the detailed statement for the amount drawn by him to the warden, on the first day of the following month, without fail.
- Members inviting guests should intimate their intentions to the Mess Manager/cook, at least 12 hours before the meals are served to them.
- All servants of the kitchen shall be under the control of Assistant Warden who may recommend punishment, such as warning, penalties for bad meal preparation etc. and all complaints against them shall be dealt with him.
- Only bona fide students will be eligible for mess membership.
- A member may lose his/her right for membership, if his conduct is found unsatisfactory or if he does not abide by the rules of mess, but no member shall be dismissed, without the Sanction of the Head of the Institution



## EXTRA CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES



In addition to the academic activities, recreation and co-curricular activities are essential parts of education and, therefore, have been given due importance. Besides games and sports, the students will enjoy other activities also and the Institution arranges their activities on regular basis, like:

- Picnic trips to scenic sites.
- Intra-country education trips.
- Intra-District medical camping
- Public Health-oriented Research activities.

Special arrangements in the evening for extra reading,

social and Cultural activities have been made, as a part of the daily college routine. The college has its own multimedia projector for screening documentaries and entertainment movies, via a bigger & adjustable screen, through computerized system.

### COLLEGE CAFETERIA

There is a separate independent and spacious cafeteria for girl/boy students and college staff in the academic block, where delicious food, prepared under hygienic conditions, is available at subsidized rates and very reasonable prices.



## STUDENT CONDUCT & DISCIPLINE



## A) DEFINITIONS

1. Institute means Pir Abdul Qadir Shah Jeelani Institute of Medical Sciences, Gambat.
2. Director means the Director of Pir Abdul Qadir Shah Jeelani Institute of Medical Sciences, Gambat.
3. College" means Gambat Medical College, Gambat.
4. "Principal" means the Principal of Gambat Medical College, Gambat.
5. Academic Council" means the Academic council of the Gambat Medical College-Gambat, consisting of all Professors & Heads of Departments / Incharges of the departments.
6. Disciplinary Committee" means Committee for the purpose of taking any disciplinary action.
7. Incharge Student Affairs," means an officer, appointed by Director, as an Incharge of students' affairs.
8. Administrative Officer (AO) Hostels" means administrative officer for hostels, appointed by the Director.
9. Warden" means an officer, appointed by the Director as warden of hostel.

## B GENERAL DISCIPLINE, CODE OF HONOUR & STUDENTS CONDUCT

These rules are applicable to undergraduate students of the college

### 1. NO STUDENT SHALL BE ALLOWED TO:

- i. Form any type of political association/ organization



- ii. Invite any outsider to address any meeting,



at the college institute/hospital etc, whether academic, social, religious or political, without prior written permission of the authorities. Decision of authorities will be final and taken on case-to case basis.

- iii. Paste any poster, pamphlet, banners or graffiti wall chalking), on the wall, in the premises of the institute college/hospital etc.
- iv. Roam around or play in the premises, during teaching hours and or Clinical posting. The girl-students are advised to roam in groups (two or more).
- v. Arrange any program, picnic, musical concerts, sports activities etc. on their own, without prior written permission from the authorities.
- vi. Collect money for any purpose, whatsoever.
- vii. Address the Print & Electronic Media or the national press, on any subject for any complaint or grievance, personal or institutional, without permission.
- viii. Possess or use weapon and/ or any other harmful items, inside the premises of Institute/ college/hospital/hostels.
- ix. Enter administrative / department offices, I.T Department or teaching areas like laboratory, lecture hall of the institution or department, without purpose or prior permission.
- x. Use office equipment/ machinery like telephone, computer, printer, typewriter, overhead projector, or multimedia etc, without prior permission.
- xi. Park his / her car inside the premises of the college /institute, unless specially allowed by the competent authority.



2. Smoking, Paan & Gutka-chewing, alcohol, Naswar or any other narcotic substance, littering and spitting are prohibited in the classrooms, laboratories, seminar/tutorial rooms, library, during the college hours and wards in clinical postings.
3. Institute or college identity Card (ID), should be displayed, at all times, when the students are in the premises of the Institute College/Hospital etc. Faculty members and security staff are authorized to check I.D cards, at any time.
4. The Students should wear apron / white coat, during classes, Labs and hospital postings.
5. All communications intended for higher authorities need to be routed, through proper channel i.e. Principal.

### **C) STUDENTS Disciplinary RULES & PROCEDURES**

Any student involved in violating the discipline or committing in-disciplinary act shall be dealt with, in accordance with the College Institute conduct rules and the procedures mentioned bellow:-

1. College will have Disciplinary Committee to be notified, with the approval of the Director to deal with all the disciplinary matters.
2. The Principal on suo-motu or on any complaint, may initiate action against any student of the college, refer the case to the Disciplinary Committee of the college for appropriate recommendations.
3. After recommendations of Disciplinary Committee against the student and before taking any action, the Principal shall serve a show-cause notice to the student, indicating the charges against him/her

to reply within Seven days. He/She will be offered a chance for personal hearing, after which the Principal of the college is empowered to suspend, rusticate or expel the student, as per rules.

4. The student, whom the Principal has suspended, rusticated or expelled from the college may appeal to the Director against the decision of the Principal, within 07 days. Decision of Director shall be final and binding.
5. Any student, whose name appears in F.I.R, pertaining to any Non-bailable offence, as specified in the criminal procedure code (Cr.P.C) will be suspended. During the pendency of the case he /she will not be allowed to attend the classes or take up any examination.

### **D) PENALTIES**

#### **(A) WARNING/SUSPENSION:**

Acts of misconduct, liable for warning/ suspension (from all academic activities), for period, up to six months.

1. Misbehaves or quarrels with any teacher or member of the staff.
2. Is generally disobedient.
3. Spreads false rumors.
4. Uses indecent or filthy language.
5. Incites other students to violence.
6. Is inappropriately dressed,
7. Shouts, abuses, quarrels or fights with fellow students.
8. Raises slogans to hurt others, politically or religiously.
9. Interferes with the administration, including the





mode or schedule of the examination or internal assessment.

10. Indulges in acts of immorality.
11. Indulges in any kind of political activity, including displaying posters or placard, within the Institution premises.
12. Remains absent continuously for more than 4 weeks, without prior permission.

Any student, who commits any of (or all above) acts of misconduct, is liable to one or more of the following penalties.

- i. The student maybe asked to tender an apology, in writing. This shall be placed on the students record.
- ii. A student may be placed on probation for a period, up to one year. If during the period of probation, he/she fails to improve the conduct, may be rusticated from college on case-to-case basis.
- iii. A student maybe fined up to Rs. 50,000/-
- iv. Principal of college if finds necessary may suspend the student for a period not exceeding ten days for pending enquiry into the misconduct of the student.



- v. The student maybe suspended from college roll not exceeding six months.

## (B) RUSTICATION

A Student maybe rusticated for a period extending up to 3 years, due to any of the following acts:

- i. Taking forceful possession, making unauthorized use or damaging any property.
- ii. Involving in any agitational activity.
- iii. Found indulging in activities, pre-judicial and detrimental to the good order of the college.
- iv. Adopting unfair means, during examination.
- v. Disobeying an order of suspension.



**Note:** Any student rusticated for the reasons mentioned above shall not be allowed to attend classes or appear in the examination/ reside hostels and treated, as persona non grata.

## (C) EXPULSION

A student is liable to be expelled from the college, if he/she commits any of the following acts and this order shall be final and irrevocable, if the student:

1. Is found in possession of fire arms or lethal weapons or narcotic drugs like, cannabis (Bhang, Charas), cocaine & opium products (Heroin) etc, in the college premises, hostels, examination halls, teaching hospitals or any other area, as specified by the college administration.
2. Remains absent for more than three months, without permission of the Principal/Director, the admission shall be cancelled by the disciplinary committee of the college.
3. Student convicted by the court of law for any criminal offence.
